Background

As an Electrical Fitter (Substations) Apprentice you will construct and maintain electrical infrastructure including switching and rectifying faults with plant and equipment, across both distribution and transmission networks from 22 to 500kV.

Predominately operating in a substation environment, you must be willing to work outdoors on ladders and elevated work platforms in all weather conditions.

This position will include time spent working away from home.
