Apprentice Meter Technician Certificate III Electrotechnology – Electrician

Background

The Meter Technician Apprenticeship will be conducted over a four year period, incorporating both formal training and "in field" (on the job) segments.

As a Meter Technician your work will involve the installation, maintenance and testing of energy metering and associated communication equipment. Pending business requirements, an A Grade Electrician's licence may be obtained throughout the course of the Apprenticeship.
